



## **Information on intraday congestion management of interconnector capacity**

ČEPS, a. s. (CEPS), E.ON Netz GmbH (E.ON) and Vattenfall Europe Transmission GmbH (VE-T) inform market participants that principles of a common trilateral intraday cross-border transmission procedure (Intraday) on borders CEPS/E.ON and CEPS/VE-T have been agreed. Implementation of the trilateral Intraday procedure is planned on 16 April 2008.

CEPS will be the contact point for market participants for the Intraday procedure. Requests for Intraday transactions shall be submitted through the Damas ePortal operated by CEPS.

Intraday procedure is arranged in 6 sessions a day in 7 days a week operation. Time, number and length of the sessions may be modified in future depending on needs of the Intraday operation.

Requests for Intraday transaction are processed in the order in which they were delivered, as defined by a timestamp attached to each request upon delivery to the Damas ePortal server. The evaluation is based on "first come first served" principle and there is not payment for capacity reservation.

CEPS, E.ON and VE-T give highest priority to the development of coordinated congestion management solutions in order to maximise opportunities for trade and cross-border balancing in accordance to the Regulation (EC) No. 1228/2003 and its Guidelines.
